PRACTICE DIRECTION G-5 **Transmission to the Office of the Court by technological means of certain applications made with consent (art. 378 C.C.P.)**

Please be advised that the applications listed below may be transmitted to the Office of the Court by fax or e-mail if the other parties so consent:

- Applications for substitution of a lawyer;
- Applications for the consolidation or separation of appeals;
- Applications for extension of time limits;
- Applications for authorization to file supplementary statements.

These applications, made in writing and notified to the other parties (art. 378, para.3 C.C.P.), must indicate, *inter alia*, the consent of the parties and/or be accompanied by evidence of such consent. Documents may be notified to the Office of the Court by fax or e-mail in the district where the file has been opened:

In all cases, a judge or clerk may summon the parties to a hearing if that judge or clerk considers it necessary. In addition, where that judge or clerk believes the interest of justice so requires, a clerk may refer an application to a judge, or a judge may refer an application to a panel of the Court of Appeal (art. 378, para. 3 C.C.P.).
