## DIRECTIVE OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE COURT OF APPEAL OF QUEBEC

Subject: Special Authorization – Court of Appeal of Quebec – Ernest-Cormier Building

RE: 4.1.2. of the Security Procedure

In accordance with the section 4.1.2 of the Security Procedure in force at the Ernest-Cormier Building of the Court of Appeal of Quebec, the present directive is effective as of February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

- 1 The following persons will be exempt from the search procedure in force at the 100 Notre-Dame East entrance of the Ernest-Cormier Building:
  - Attorneys who present their Barreau du Quebec membership card in good standing <u>and</u> a photo identification (e.g.: Driver's licence, health care card, etc.)
  - Articled students who present their Ecole du Barreau du Quebec card in good standing **and** a photo identification (e.g.: Driver's licence, health care card, etc.)
  - Bailiffs who present their Ordre des huissiers du Quebec membership card in good standing with photo;
  - The employee of the Minister of Justice or of the Director of Criminal and Penal Prosecutions holder of a personal access card for the Ernest-Cormier Building.
- 2 However, these persons will have to leave all dangerous objects which can be used as a weapon, notably sharp or cutting objects, in holding at the Security post of the main entrance on Notre-Dame East or at the attorneys' lounge in a locked locker cabinet. Any deviation from this directive could result in the expulsion of the person at fault by the special constables.
- 3 These exemptions may be suspended in the possibility of special circumstances (e.g.: demonstrations, threats, bomb alerts, etc.) as provided by the section 5.3 of the SECURITY PROCEDURE.
