CLERK'S PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 10

TYPES OF FILES THAT ARE LEGIBLE BY THE MEANS AVAILABLE TO THE COURT OF APPEAL

In accordance with s. 43 (j)(ii) of the *Rules of the Court of Appeal of Quebec in Criminal Matters*, the clerk shall publish a notice indicating the types of files that are legible by the means available to the Court.

These types of files are the following:

- <u>Audio files</u> Formats: MP3, MPEG, OGG Vorbis, AC3, WMA, WAV, FLAC, MIDI, Real Audio, MACE;
- <u>Video files</u> Formats: MP4, MOV, AVI, MKV, MTS, MPEG, DivX, WMV, XviD, Theora, Real Video;
- <u>Photos</u> Formats: PNG, JPG;
- Other types of files Excel, PowerPoint, TXT.

The filing of all other types of files requires prior authorization from the clerk, in accordance with the Clerk's Practice Direction No. 9 – *Method for Presenting Certain Requests in Criminal Matters.*
